Defensive Tactics

July 6 - 10, 2009

This "Instruct the Instructor" course is designed for individuals recently assigned to or who are currently teaching Defensive Tactics. Topics to be covered include a historical and contemporary perspective of the PPCT Management, Inc. approach to the high risk nature of Defensive Tactics Training. Mastery of its training methodology and techniques to protect officers and minimize agency liability. Course content includes the following:

Fundamentals of Route Development

July 7 - 9, 2009

Aimed at airport professionals of all levels, this course is structured in three distinct stage designed to give delegates a clearer understanding of an airport's market opportunity, an airport's airline customers, and most importantly, how to win and deliver new routes. The aim of the course is to facilitate the transfer of know-how from some of the industry's leading consultants into the recipient airports and to develop their marketing and analysis skills. These skills result in a more focused and productive approach to route development by the airports. The attraction of new air services to the airports will bring direct financial benefit to the airport and indirectly to the local economy through increased passenger numbers and improved access to the region.

PREREQUISITE: Current employment at a regional Airport and nomination from agency.

Oleoresin Capsicum Aerosol Instructor Training

July 11, 2009

This course is designed for individuals recently assigned to or who are currently teaching Aerosol O.C. chemical weapon deployment. Topics to be covered include a historical and contemporary perspective of O.C. spray. Students will be able to: identify the conflict stages in order to recognize and reduce the threat and determine how and when to use force; apply state-of-the-art tactical concepts such as spraying techniques, disengagement, proper defensive positions, movement methods, multiple opponent defense, contact and cover system, defense against moving attacks, ground defense, and drawing techniques; avoid liability suits through certified training, understanding the effects of O.C. spray, identifying factors which justify O.C. use, and proper O.C. incident documentation.

PREREQUISITE: Current law enforcement officer.
