GIAA Reviews Airport Emergency Plan

Each Federal Aviation Regulation Part 139 certificate holder is required to conduct a review of its airport emergency plan. This review is in preparation

for the overall review with designated mutual aid organizations and parties which is scheduled for September 13, 2023. This review occurs at least once every 12 consecutive calendar months, to ensure that all parties know their responsibilities and that all information in the AEP is current.

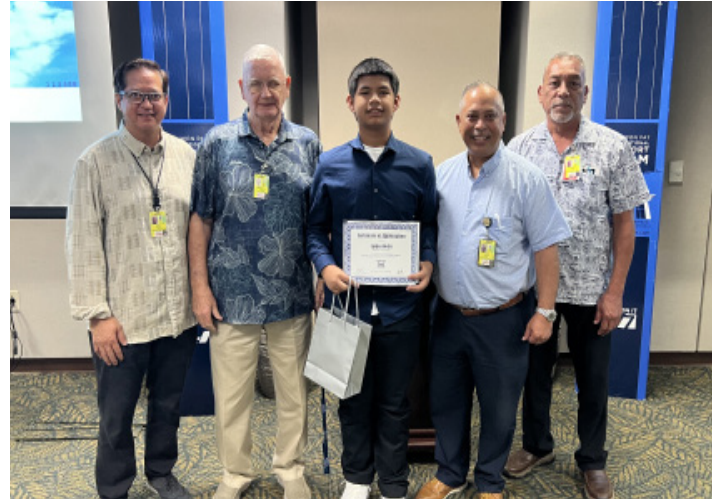




GIAA Summer Interns Complete Work Program

This eight-week training is the second for GIAA and is the highest level of law enforcement training in developing tactical operators. Advanced Tactical Firearms, Close Quarter Battle, Tactical Repelling, Tactical Tracking, Bus and Aircraft Assault with a concentration in hostage response training, Dignitary Protection and Riot Control Techniques, and Operational Planning for Search Warrant Operations.
