## **U.S. VISA WAIVER PROGRAM**

There are 36 countries participating in the U.S. Visa Waiver Program which allows nationals of the following countries entry in Guam without a visa for a period of up to 90 days:

Travelers entering Guam under the U.S. Visa Waiver Program must obtain an Electronic System for Travel Authorization (ESTA) prior to entry and must also complete and sign a U.S. Customs & Border Protection (CBP) Form I-94W.

## **GUAM-CNMI VISA WAIVER PROGRAM**

The Guam-CNMI Visa Waiver Program allows nationals from the following countries to enter Guam or the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands (CNMI) without a visa for business or pleasure for a period of 45 days or less.

To utilize program, traveler must meet the following conditions:

- Be solely entering and staying on Guam or the CNMI for a period not to exceed 45 days
- Be in possession of a round trip ticket that is non-transferable and bears a confirmed departure date not exceeding 45 days from the date of admission to Guam or the CNMI
- Have a completed and signed CBP Form I-736 and CBP Form I-94
- Be in possession of a valid, unexpired International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) compliant, machine readable passport issued by a country that meets the eligibility requirements of this section
- Have not previously violated the terms of any prior admissions, which include those under the Guam-CNMI Visa Waiver Program, the prior Guam Visa Waiver Program, the Visa Waiver Program as described in section 217(a) of the INS and admissions pursuant to any immigrant or nonimmigrant visa
- If a resident of Taiwan, possess a Taiwan national identity Card and a valid Taiwan passport with a valid re-entry permit

- Safety Authority from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA)

Foreign air carriers must also meet licensing requirements of any other applicable U.S. Government agencies.

#### FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION (FAA) CERTIFICATIONS

All foreign carriers must obtain safety authority (commonly referred to as Part 129 Operations Specifications) granted to foreign air carriers by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA).
