



GIAA Master Plan Update



GIAA's Master Plan consultants, AECOM, were on island to hold a second series of stakeholder workshops to continue to refine and develop GIAA's Master Plan. AECOM is conducting a comprehensive study of Guam's only commercial airport that will identify short-, medium-, and long-term development plans to meet Guam's future aviation demand. The study includes needs determination, stakeholder involvement, environmental considerations, inventory of existing conditions, aviation forecasts, facility requirements, alternative development and evaluation, airport layout plan, facilities implementation plan, and financial feasibility analysis. The six officers, along with 11 others from the Guam Police Department (GPD), GPD Central Precinct Command, Port Authority of Guam Police, U.S. Air Force Security Forces, and the Superior Court of Guam, received training in firearms, close quarter battle, defensive tactics, tactical repelling, dignitary protection, crowd control, tactical tracking, riot control techniques, vehicle and bus takedown, operational planning and warrant operations, vehicle close quarter battle, spontaneous knife defense, active threat, and Chemical, Biological, Radiological, Nuclear Defense and Mask Confidence. It also provides an opportunity for relevant stakeholders to review their response procedures, plans, and decision-making processes, discover gaps, information sharing and coordination.
