#### Silebrasion Mes CHamoru! March is Guam History and CHamoru Heritage Month



Guam's official flag is proudly flown to represent Guam and the CHamoru people and heritage. The flag of Guam dates back to 1917 and was officially adopted on February 9, 1948. The oval outline of the Guam Seal represents the ancient CHamoru slingstone, a weapon skillfully wielded by our ancestors. In the seal are the Hagatña River where it meets the sea; the beach graced by a lone coconut palm that symbolizes sustenance; and a flying proa, the chief means of transportation for early CHamorus. These aspects of CHamoru culture symbolize the courage, perseverance and prowess of our ancestors. (Extracted from Guampedia.com)


