#### **GIAA Hosts Regional Cybersecurity Training**



A top-notch cybersecurity team arrived on Guam at the beginning of the new year for a weeklong series of training in Critical Infrastructure Cybersecurity at the A.B. Won Pat International Airport Authority, Guam (GIAA). The airport hosted partner airport participants from throughout the Asia Pacific region as well as those from local GovGuam departments and agencies and various branches of the U.S. military. The training, which was held January 8-12, 2024, touched on cybersecurity for control systems and industrial control systems. The airport cybersecurity training provided conceps for perfoming cybersecurity assessments of wireless access applications at airports. Participants learned techniques for identifying WiFi access points within an airport environment, analysis methods for determining wireless security gaps, and recommendations for improving defenses to defeat potential threats. Other special topics briefings touched on Operations Risk, Cybersecurity for Screening Equipment, and Workforce Development. All this training is in line with the Aviation Cyber Initiative (ACI), a multi-agency effort to identify and mitigate cyber risks within the nation's aviation ecosystem. The ACI is tri-chaired by the U.S. Departments of Homeland Security, Defense, and Transportation.
