GIAA mourned the loss of a member their family with a memorial ceremony on May 4, 2022. The Airport Family gathered to bid farewell to the late Gilbert Quinata Aquon who had been an Airport Police Officer for 16 years and had sadly lost his battle with cancer. Gilbert had first joined law enforcement in 2004 with GPD, where he had been a certified SWAT operator, maintaining that distinguished certification until his death. He joined GIAA as an Police Officer (PO) I in 2006, promoted to POII in 2015 and posthumously promoted to the rank of Lieutenant. Lt. Aguon was bestowed with the highly esteemed Medal of Valor in 2014. He was honored with a 21-gun salute by Airport Police and a water salute deployed by the Aircraft Rescue & Fire Fighting (ARFF) unit as his funeral cortege departed the airport terminal.
