effective that day. The 60-day transition period would allow eligible travelers to complete the G-CNMI ETA in lieu of a paper Form I-736. Advances that enhance passenger screening and simplify arrival procedures for travelers from Guam-CNMI Visa Waiver Program (VWP) participant countries are always welcome improvements.

2024 Guam Airport & United Airlines Health, Safety, & Wellness FAIR



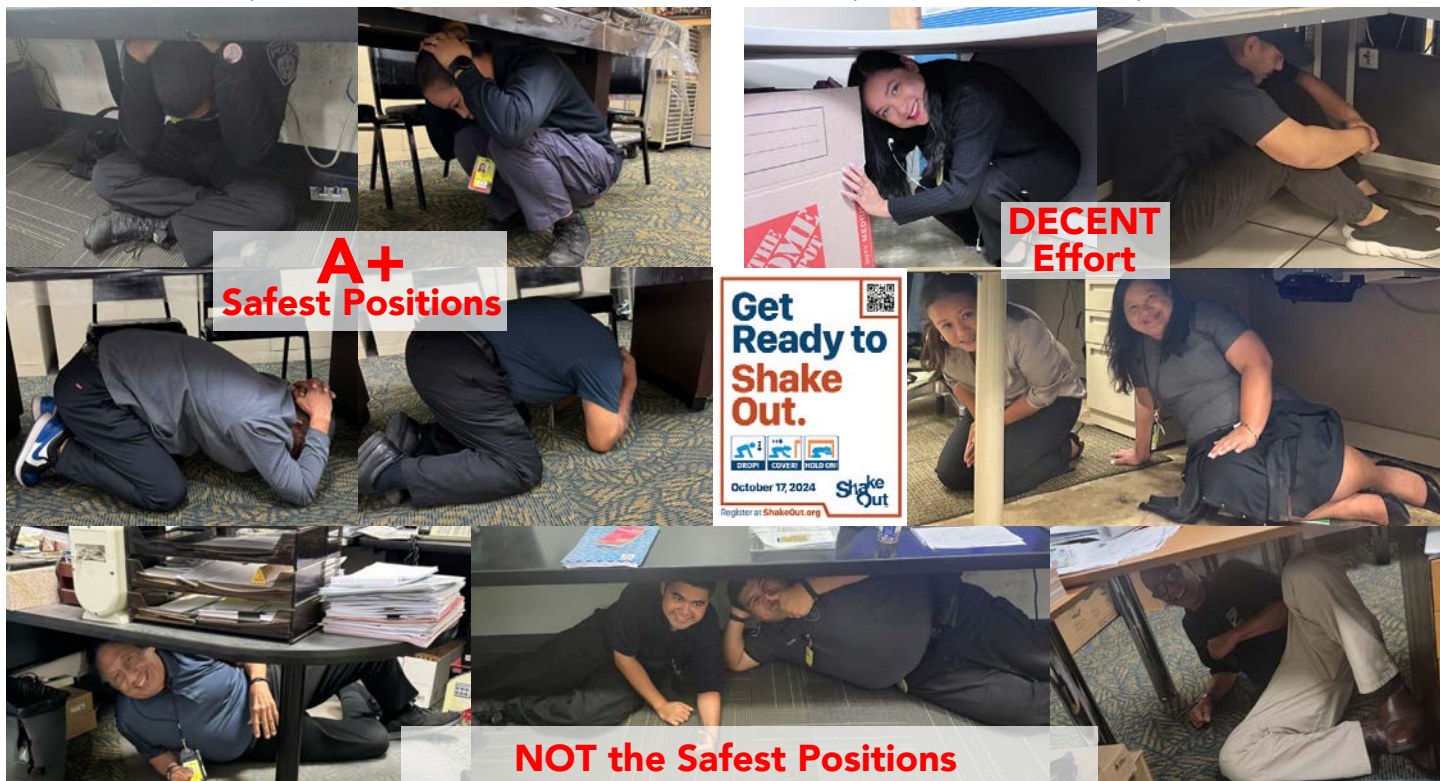

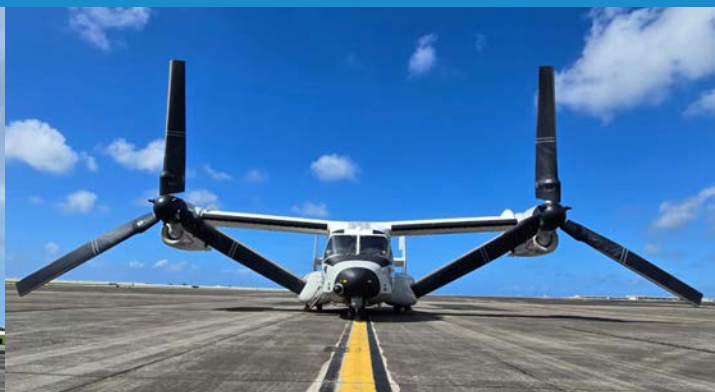


Royal Canadian Air Force HUSKY 330 Visits GUM

ARFF Gets FamTour on Amazing US Navy OSPREY Aircraft



The US Navy OSPREY aircraft "dropped in" at the Guam International Airport (GIAA) on Friday, Oct. 25th. The V-22 Osprey is an American multi-use, tiltrotor military transport and cargo aircraft that is capable of both vertical takeoff and landing (VTOL) and short takeoff and landing (STOL). The unique design combines the conventional helicopter functionality along with the long-range, high-speed cruise performance of a turboprop aircraft. During the short visit to GUM, the aircraft only operated like fixed wing aircraft and didn't execute any of the renowned vertical take-offs and landings. The Airport's ARFF crew were fortunate to get a first-hand familiarization tour of the OSPREY adding this amazing aircraft to their ever-expanding list of familiar aircraft.

DRILLS Keep ARFF and Airport Police On Their READINESS Toes



A critical component of airport operations is to meet the stringent requirements of our federal certification is to have highly qualified and trained fire fighting and law enforcement units. Our GIAA ARFF and Airport Police have drills to constantly train and to meet our airport index criteria. These drills are not scheduled and are called at a moments notice. ARFF and Police recently participated in a Limited Readiness Drill (photos above) which had ARFF roll out to the South Ramp and discharge water within their required 3-minute response time but this drill included coordination with

Airport Police and the Agana Control Tower to respond to a hypothetical emergency from the Airport's Emergency Plan (AEP). ARFF Unit 5 and Chief 2 were on scene in 2min. 29sec. with Units 6 & 7 together with Airport Police on site within a minute. ARFF also executed their Timed Response Drill with support from Airport Police successfully meeting the time requirements for our Airport (photos below). The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) continues to push for emergency readiness and responses, holding the nation's airports to very high standards.

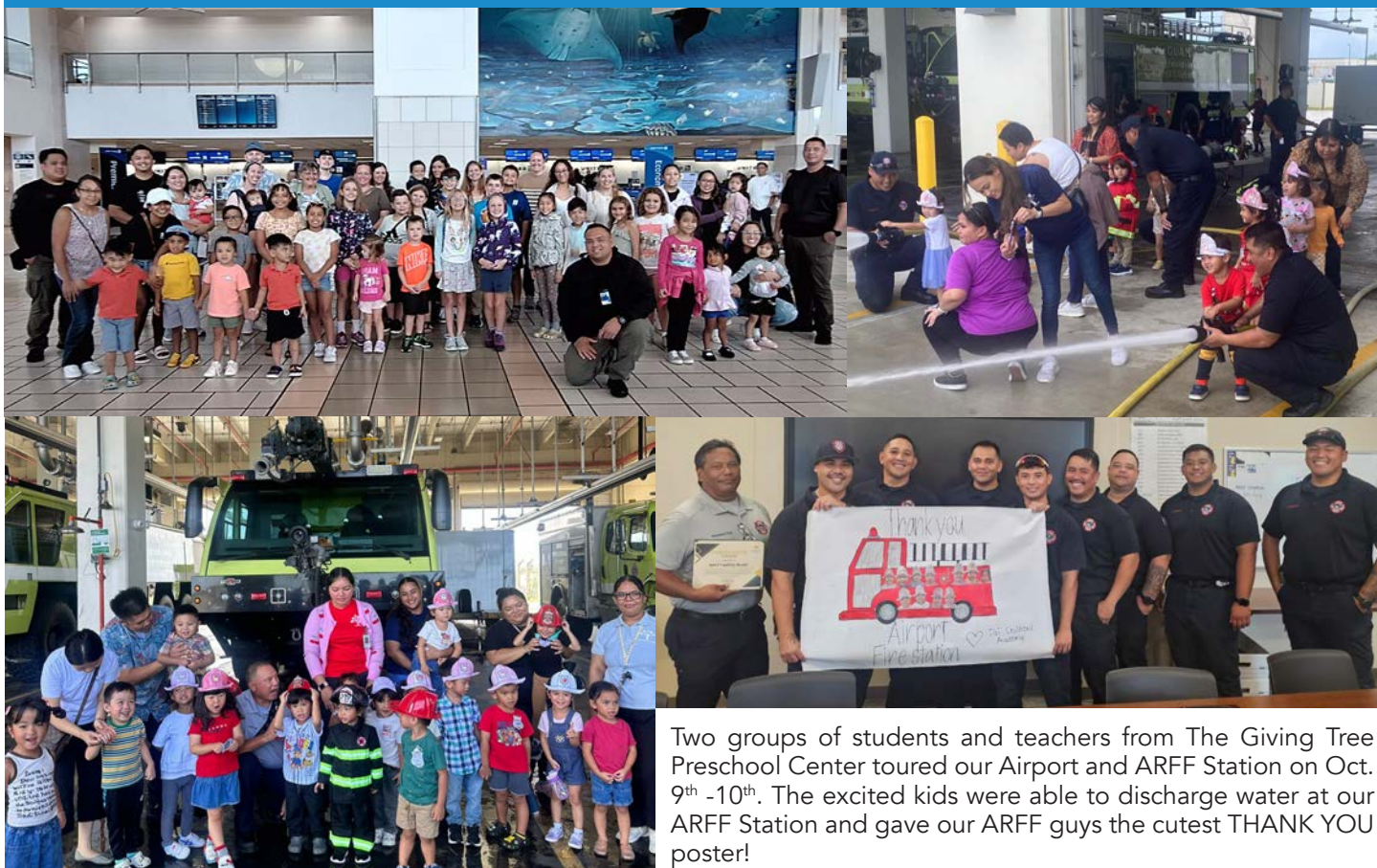
USEPA & GUAM EPA Host TTX on Fuel Emergency Response
