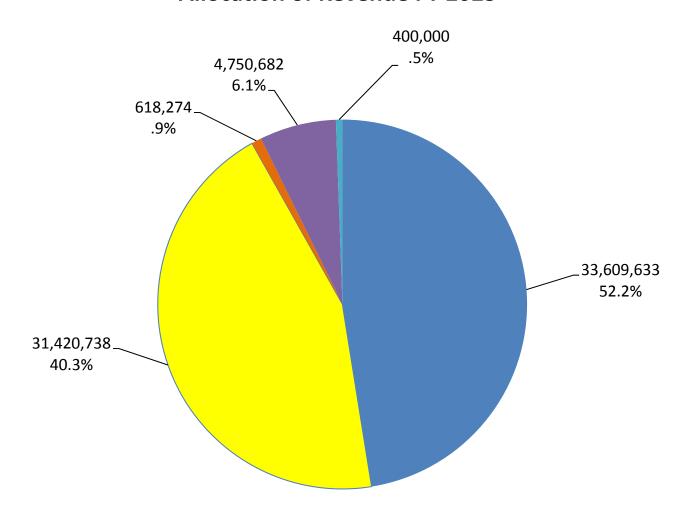

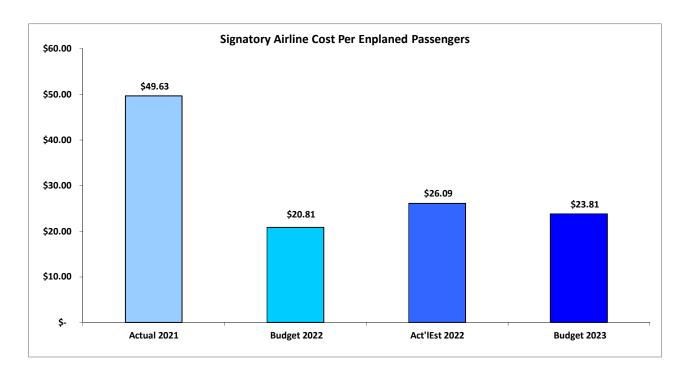

Allocation of Revenue FY 2023



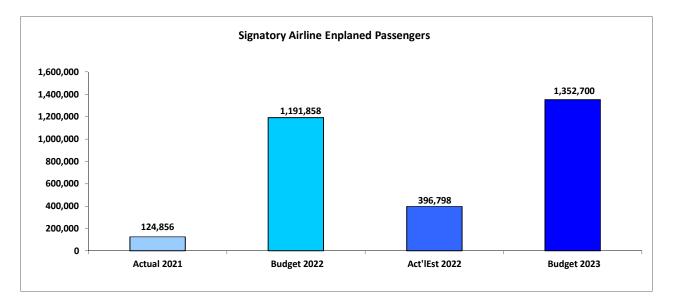

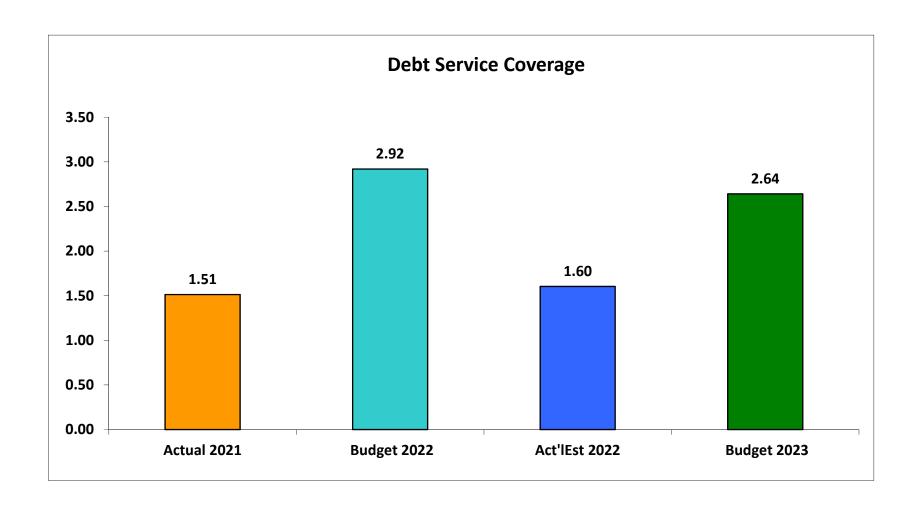

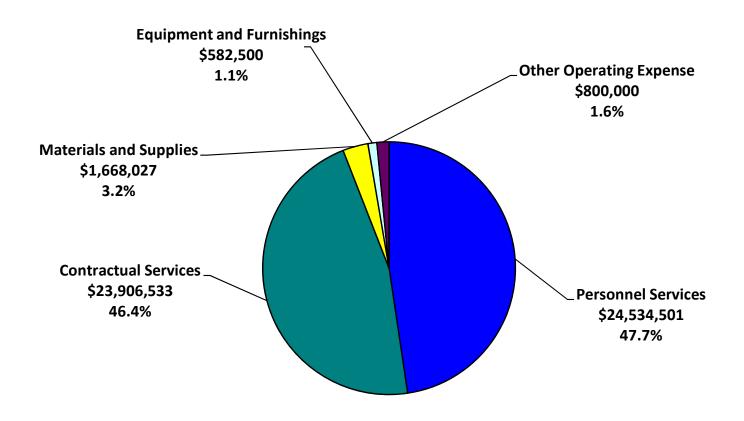
