Triennial Full Scale Disaster Drill on May 22, 2014

The public is advised that the A.B. Won Pat International Airport Authority, Guam will be conducting its Triennial Full Scale Disaster Drill Exercise on **Thursday, May 22, 2014**. As part of the drill, emergency responders (police vehicles, firefighting trucks, ambulances, federal vehicles, etc.) will be activated and will be simulating a live response on and in the vicinity of the Airport.

The public is also advised that temporary road closures may occur from **8:45am to 9:00am** in the following areas:

- **Rte. 8 & Central Avenue into Tiyan intersection (former NAS Main Gate)** – this will affect access into Tiyan
- **Rte. 8 & Connector Road intersection (across Mobil/McDonald's)** – this will affect access into Tiyan
- **Rte. 8 & Admiral Sherman Road intersection (across Golden Sea Restaurant)** – this will affect access into Tiyan
- **The "Y" intersection on Rte. 10-A (Chalan Pasaheru) heading up towards the Airport terminal)** – this will affect northbound traffic trying to access Tiyan and the main terminal
- **The first traffic light northbound after the "Y" intersection on Rte. 10-A)** – this will affect South bound traffic turning left into Tiyan and the main terminal.

Every three years, the A. B. Won Pat International Airport Authority, Guam is required by federal regulations to conduct a full-scale crash drill on Airport property to test the Airport's Emergency Plan. *The exercise is only a drill and will not affect the normal operations of the airport facility or any regularly scheduled flight activity.*
